

Gloss Finish	High transparency, good dimensional stability, excellent slip, high resistance to water, oils, greases, etc. High resistance to scratching and creasing.
Matt Finish	Excellent matt surface finish, easy to process, high resistance to folding and tearing. Giving superior performance in printing varnishing and foil blocking.
Silk Finish	This relatively new film appears midway between gloss and matt film lamination and imparts a smooth natural finish to brochures, book covers, etc. giving excellent clarity to the underlying print, scratch and scuff resistance superior to that of matt film.

u.v. varnishing

OFF - LINE U.V VARNISHING REMAINS as popular now as it was when we first became involved in the process some ten years ago. We have upgraded ours equipment during this time and our U.V. operators are highly skilled individuals who ensure that only top quality work leaves our premises.

The deep lustre finish which we achieve is illustrated throughout this brochure and cannot be matched exactly by in-line methods.

Graphic designers, packaging producers and commercial printers regularly specify U.V. varnish either in total coverage or spot format which can go from a large proportion of the sheet right down to fine and intricate detail work.

re-moist gumming

rub removable ink application

For best results and ease of removal, paper stocks require to be sealed prior to rub-removable ink being applied.

ACA has consistently updated and upgraded the facilities in this important department. We cover a range of sheet sizes from A5 up to B1 and accommodate both paper and board stock ranging from 80gsm to 2000 micron (Display Board). We have skilled, long-term operators who are capable of producing top-class work, whether from sheets requiring basic cutting and/or creasing, to the demands of volume kiss-cutting (e.g. peel-off labels on self-adhesive materials). Embossing/Debossing can vary from the smallest symbol or logo to a die approaching full sheet size, all produced to perfection.

We carry a range of perforating rule to cover most applications and regularly carry out this process for tear-off replies, cheques, application forms, etc. Whatever the application, this department plays a key role in print finishing and we are very proud of the work we do within it. We produce all cutters in house, by either conventional, or laser-cut methods. Providing we have a keyline, sample ruled-up sheet or disc to work from, we will always be able to move on a job without delay.* We have been foil-blocking for many years and have seen trends change. We provide this facility as an integral part of a comprehensive range of finishing processes.

The process is widely used within general and commercial printing, which has become the mainstay of this section, although specialist and demanding tight register work on whisky labels, tube wraps, financial report covers, book jackets, etc. are a regular feature of our workload.

Typical outlines for automatic folder gluing. **(Non-capacity)**






